Trust's Top 10 Wildlife Wonders of 2018

Friday 21st December, 2018

2018 has been a very mixed year for Cornwall's wildlife. Nationally 56% of UK species have declined in recent years, some of them at an alarming rate. Work on local species data at the Environmental Records Centre for Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly (ERCCIS) showed that the same thing is happening here in Cornwall. It isn't all bad news though, there are many examples where species decline has been reversed in small areas, but this will need to be scaled up if we are to bring species like hedgehogs and skylarks back from the brink. New Government legislation due in 2019 could help to turn things around if it is strong enough.
