Booking Community Group Visits

We ask that groups planning a visit do book so that we can ensure we have enough staff, volunteers and parking available for you. We aim to provide each group with a guide to help you get the most out of your visit and answer your questions, however you are welcome to visit without this service. We recommend you allow at least one and a half hours for your visit. Due to restrictions on resources we are only able to accept bookings for the current season.

Adult Community Group Visits

Cost	We ask for a donation of £4.00 per person, free for MWT members
Group Size	We can accommodate a maximum group size of 30 people at any one time

Health and Safety	We ask that you follow the directions of our staff and volunteers at all time while on the reserve.

Children's Community Group Visits

Cost	We ask for a donation of £3.00 per child, free for the accompanying adults though you are welcome to make a donation if you enjoy your visit
Group Size	Maximum group size of 20 children, plus accompanying adults
Health and Safety	We ask that you follow the directions of our staff and volunteers at all time while on the reserve. Please be aware that the adults accompanying the group remain responsible for safety and discipline at all times.
