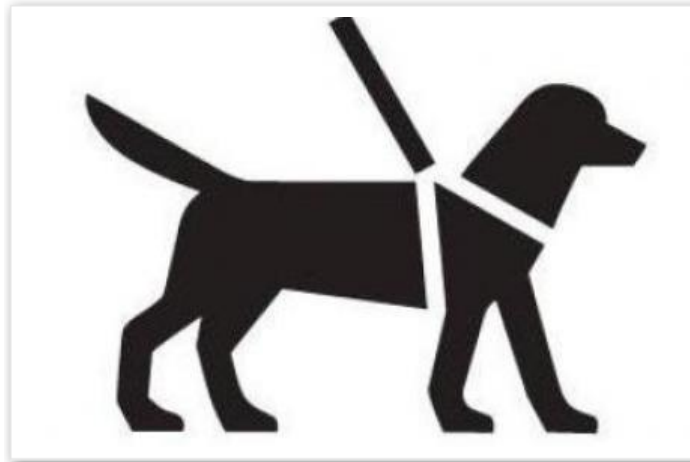

Protect local wildlife





We do not allow dogs, except assistance dogs, onto Cors Dyfi Reserve.

Over the last few years the uses and function of the reserve together with the Observatory and boardwalk have changed significantly meaning we have had to take the difficult decision to not allow dogs on to the reserve.

The opening of the 360 Observatory has meant that people are now visiting for much longer than previously, sometimes for several hours at a time. We are also conducting much more scientific research from the boardwalk at Cors Dyfi including moth trapping, mammal trapping, dormouse boxes and otter holt surveys. In addition we also now have areas of the boardwalk specifically for education, pond dipping areas for example where children can explore the wildlife around them by sitting and sometimes laying on the boardwalk.

Please note however, **dogs are still welcome in the car park** where they can be taken for short walks.
