The Dyfi Osprey project is open from the **end of March** until the **beginning of September** each year. During this time it is open from 10.00am - 5.30pm seven days a week. Last entry is 5.00pm.

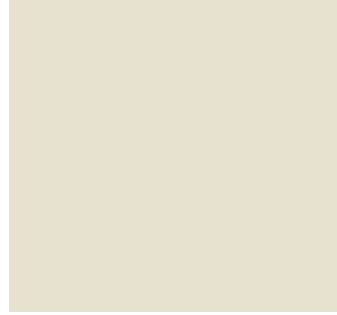
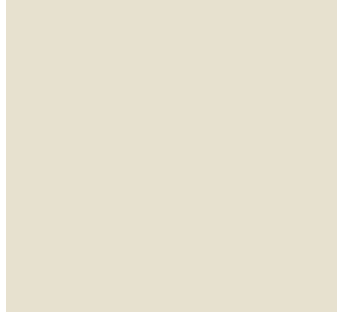
