- Our hearts blaze with the fire of compasion.

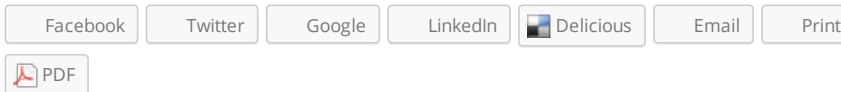
O, awesome Mystical Body of Christ, we bow in reverent respect before all God's people,
