They will teach you wisdom and understanding.

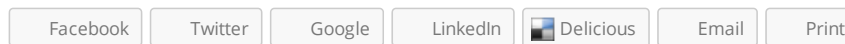
Speak to me in the quiet; don't be afraid to question.
