## ENGLISH FOR PROGRESS

1. Congratulations on your choosing English for Language paper. It is easier than Tamil. How long, do you think, will it require to prepare for it? Believe me. Just two hours! BY just going through the 9th and 10th standard work book, you can easily cover 90 percent of the portion. you can do it in just 2 hours. For the remaining part, you need to refresh the grammar rules and to do some practice. That's all.

2. Just go through the grammar areas in the work book such as Voice and Tense, Simple, Complex, compound sentences, Articles Degrees of comparison, sentence pattern, Tag questions, Prefix and suffix and phrasal verbs. These areas will cover serventy five percent of the questions.

3. Twenty five percent of questions will be from the following 5 areas.

1. Comprehension 2. Prepositions 3. Spot the error 4. Choose the correct sentence 5. Plural forms of some nouns.

4. Preparing for the areas of preposition and spot the error, is not just an one day affair. You need to do a lot of practice. You may refer the following books. "Common errors and how to correct them" by Upkar Publication. "Objective English" by Harimohan Prasad.

5. Some verbs will always be followed by definite prepositions such as congratulate on, deal in (things) deal with (person), Become familiar with these kind of verbs. Some nouns are always used in plural sense. Eg: cattle, police, majority, people.

6. Some words have peculiar plural forms. For instance, ox-oxen, critarien -critaria, Singular and plural forms are same for some words. Eg: Fish, deer, Lock for these words. Some nouns are "True plurals" and have no singular forms. Eg: scissors, pants, alms, ashes, spectacles. The following nouns are (though plural form) used ALWAYS in singular. News, Summons, Gallowns, Physics, Mathematics. Other words used in singular are:- Machinery, scenery, poetry, information furniture.

7. As far as comprehension area is concerned, you need to practise 5 to 10 exercise. It will be very easy. If you practise these exercise. The reason why we practice this Exercises is just to save time.

8. Daily memorize 10 new words and make sentences using them. When you come across a new word, Immediately jot down and memorise it. It will be extremely helpful to you in answering the comprehension area.

9. You can finish the 100 questions in just 35 to 45 minutes. What is more, it is more scoring, easier and more interesting practise it. Beef up your qualifications. Be prepared to burn the midnight oil to equip yourself for a new career. The preparation is very strenous, you should be mentally, emotionally and physically prepared to take on the challenge. Keep it in your mind. English for progress. Love it. Enjoy it. Look for words.
