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Antitrust Guidance (PDF, PDF - 95 KB)	08/16/2012
The antitrust laws protect competition and prohibit collusion. Price fixing, bid rigging, and other forms of collusion, including agreements to allocate customers or divide markets, are illegal.

Medicare payment for upgrades will be based upon the payment amount applicable to the item in the area in which the beneficiary resides...	
Change of Ownership (PDF, PDF - 122 KB)	01/24/2014
A DMEPOS supplier participating in the competitive bidding program that is negotiating a change of ownership (CHOW) must notify CMS 60 days before the anticipated date of the change.	
Common Ownership and Control (PDF, PDF - 166 KB)	08/16/2012
Suppliers are prohibited from competing against themselves when submitting bids in the DMEPOS Competitive Bidding Program. Therefore, suppliers that are commonly owned or commonly controlled must submit one bid for the same product category in the same CBA.

Contract suppliers are responsible for fulfilling all terms of their contracts, starting on the very first day of the contract period, for the duration of the contract period. Here are key contract terms with which contract suppliers must comply throughout the contract period.

DMEPOS Quality Standards	03/15/2016
Medicare enrolled DMEPOS suppliers, including DMEPOS Competitive Bidding Program contract suppliers, must meet the DMEPOS quality standards.	
Eligibility Requirements (PDF, PDF - 161 KB)	08/16/2012
A supplier must meet certain eligibility requirements before it can submit a bid and be awarded a contract under the DMEPOS Competitive Bidding Program.	
Enteral Nutrition (PDF, PDF - 114 KB)	08/09/2012
With the exception of SNFs and NFs that become specialty suppliers, suppliers that are contract suppliers for the enteral nutrition product category must furnish services to beneficiaries throughout the competitive bidding area (CBA), regardless of whether a beneficiary lives in a private residence or institutional setting.

<p> Exemptions from the Requirement to Be a Contract Supplier for Competitively Bid Items and Services (PDF, PDF - 131 KB)</p> <p>Non-contract suppliers that furnish competitively bid items in a CBA are not eligible for Medicare Part B payment for the competitively bid items for that CBA unless one or more of the exceptions listed applies.</p>	
<p> Grandfathering for Oxygen and Oxygen Equipment (PDF, PDF - 106 KB)</p> <p>Suppliers that are not awarded a competitive bidding contract for furnishing oxygen and oxygen equipment in a CBA can decide to be grandfathered suppliers for beneficiaries to whom they are furnishing these items at the time the competitive bidding program is implemented.</p>	08/16/2012
<p> Grandfathering for Rented DME (PDF, PDF - 97 KB)</p> <p>Suppliers that are not awarded a competitive bidding contract for furnishing rented DME in a CBA can decide to be grandfathered suppliers for beneficiaries to whom they are furnishing these items at the time the competitive bidding program is implemented.</p>	08/16/2012
<p>Grandfathering Requirements for Non-Contract Suppliers Fact Sheet </p> <p>Suppliers that are not awarded a competitive bidding contract for furnishing rented DME and/or oxygen and oxygen equipment in a CBA can decide to be grandfathered suppliers for beneficiaries to whom they are furnishing these items at the time the competitive bidding program is implemented.</p>	11/12/2013
<p>Hospitals That Are Not Contract Suppliers </p> <p>For the first phase of competitive bidding, one exception allows hospitals to furnish competitively bid walkers in a CBA to their own patients without submitting a bid and being selected as a contract supplier.</p>	04/25/2016

This includes maintaining compliance with all applicable state and local licensing requirements pertaining to functions under your contract throughout the duration of the contract period.</p>	10/01/2013
<p>Physicians and Other Treating Practitioners Who Are Enrolled as Medicare DMEPOS Suppliers </p> <p>Physicians and other treating practitioners who are enrolled as Medicare DMEPOS suppliers may furnish certain competitively bid items in a CBA to their own patients without submitting a bid and being selected as a contract supplier if specific requirements are met.</p>	04/25/2016
<p> Prescription for Specific Brand or Mode of Delivery to Avoid an Adverse Medical Outcome (PDF, PDF - 112 KB)</p> <p>The Medicare DMEPOS Competitive Bidding Program includes a special beneficiary safeguard to ensure that beneficiaries have access to specific brands or modes of delivery of competitively bid items when needed to avoid an adverse medical outcome.</p>	08/16/2012
<p>Repairs and Replacements </p> <p>This fact sheet contains important information about repairs and replacements of beneficiary-owned equipment under the DMEPOS Competitive Bidding Program.</p>	01/01/2018
